

CRAFTERS CLUB TUTORIAL

HORSE P.P.E.

Desperate times call for desperate measures! Reassure your anxious horses by dressing them up in P.P.E to protect them from all the nasties out there in the paddock. Or, just give your family a laugh! (This tutorial is abiding by the rules of P.P.E. It is single use and doesn't hold together very well xD)

You will need: Visor: -Clear plastic (from toy boxes etc.) -Cardboard -Sharpie/black paint -1x small white rubber band -Glue (cold and hot glue) -Scissors

Mask: -1x small white rubber band -Scrap of glove

Gown: -1x disposable glove -6x rubber bands



For the visor:

- 1. Cut a square of clear plastic and bend it into thirds
- 2. Cut 2 strips of cardboard and colour them black
- 3. Glue these strips either side of the visor
- 4. Apply liberal amounts of hot glue to the underside of the visor
- 5. Stick your rubber band to this

6. Carefully put round your horse's face. The rubber band breaks easily away from the hot glue, so be careful.

For the mask:

- 1. Cut a scrap out of the gloves
- 2. Apply glue to the back of the scrap
- 3. Fold it into the rubber band, so you have a half circle covered
- 4. Once glue is dried, trim the excess so you have a circle, half covered, half not.
- 5. Again, carefully pull the rubber band side behind your horse's ears. The rubber band also breaks away from the glove very easily

For the gown:

- 1. Cut the main hand part out of the glove so you have a big piece of rubber
- 2. Cut this shape out of it (see below), remembering a slit for the neck


3. Tie rubber bands around the different part of the gown, the legs and belly, to hold it in place.

4. For the tail piece, cut the thumb or pinky (depending on how long the tail is) out of the glove and pull over the tail, tying in place with a rubber band.


