

## **CRAFTERS CLUB TUTORIAL#1**

#### **HALTERS**

This halter is based on the classic Schleich halters, so get one out to copy off if you have one.

#### You will need:

-Ribbon -Thin cereal box card (painted metallic colour for better effect, optional)

-Chain -Needle and thread (optional) -Hot glue/PVA

-Scissors -Jump rings x2 -Pliers

## Steps:

- 1. Measure a length of ribbon that goes from your model's nostrils, over the ears, and to the nostrils on the other side of the face, and cut it off.
- 2. Thread a jump ring ½ a cm down the ribbon, fold over the ribbon, and either glue it or sew it on. (If sewing, at least two loops around the ribbon should secure it)
- 3. Repeat on the other end of the ribbon, so the ribbon now has a jump ring on each end.
- 4. For the noseband, measure a length of ribbon that goes over the bridge of the nose, or where if the horse is a draft or Arabian, the dish/roman bulge would be.
- 5. Like with what you did to the other piece, sew/glue each end to each ring.
- 6. Now, to make your halter secure and adjustable, measure out a length of chain, about double the length of the noseband, plus or minus.
- 7. Open one end of the chain with pliers, (look for the part where each link attaches) and clip it onto one of the jump rings, closing it around the jump ring.
- 8. Thread the other end of the chain through the other jump ring, and clip it onto the first jump ring.

## Nameplate:

- 9. Cut a tiny piece of cardboard out in the shape shown (or any shape you like), but make sure it is smaller than the width of the ribbon.
- 10. Write the name of your horse on the tiny nameplate
- 11. Glue this onto the side of your halter.
- 12.Done!
