



STABLE TOYS TUTORIAL

Add that extra touch of realism to your stables while keeping your ponies entertained with these 3 types of stable toys, a salt lick, horse ball and swinger.

SALT LICK

You will need:

- Salt
- Food colouring (pink)
- Modelling clay
- Small container lid

1. Pour about 1tsp of salt into your small container lid
2. Add a few drops of pink food colouring to the salt and mix thoroughly with your fingers, until salt turns pink
3. Make a brick shape out of your modelling clay, a little smaller than your finger nail (or any other shape you would like)
4. Roll your brick in the salt mix, covering the outside of the brick. Knead salt into clay a little, and re-roll until covered
5. Leave to dry
6. Cover the outside of the brick with PVA glue to make sure the salt grains don't fall off, and leave to dry
7. Done!



SWINGER

You will need:

- Modelling clay (2 colours)
- Wire
- Pliers and cutters
- String

1. Roll 2 small flat circles out of modelling clay, roughly the same size
2. Make a flat cylinder shape out of your other colour of modelling clay
3. Using your pliers, create a little eye (loop) out of wire and cut it off with a small tail
4. Depending on how hard your clay sets, wait until clay is half dried before sticking your eye loop into the clay. Let it fully dry
5. Lastly, loop a small piece of string through the eye to hang up your swing



HORSE BALL

You will need:

- Modelling clay

1. Roll a small ball shape out of the modelling clay
2. Roll a thin, short snake out of modelling clay
3. Stick each end of the snake into the ball, and bend into a U shape to form the handle
4. Leave to dry
